Resolution, Providing for 12.05 Mill Levy for Fire Protection

In connection with its duty to provide for appropriate fire protection, fire prevention, and emergency medical service within the Village of Newtown, it is incumbent upon this Council to assure that appropriate revenues will be provided. The Council has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the 10 mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Newtown to meet the need for appropriate fire protection, fire prevention and emergency medical service.

Mr. Kobasuk made a motion to adopt RESOLUTION 32-2015 A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORATE OF A 12.05 MILL ADDITIONAL PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR FIRE PROTECTION, FIRE PREVENTION, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF NEWTOWN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Mr. Zornes seconded the motion. Roll Call: Mr. Harten-Yes, Mrs. McConnell-Yes, Mr. Kobasuk-Yes, Mr. Tiettmeyer-Yes, Mr. Zornes-Yes, Mr. Short-Yes. Motion Carried.

The 12.05 Mill Levy will generate \$1,049,564, stated Mr. Tiettmeyer.
