Resolution, Contract w/Westside Paving - Phase I Short Park Improvement Project

After reviewing submitted bids for Phase I of the Short Park Improvement Project, the Village Engineer advised that the bid submitted by Westside Paving in the amount of \$61,500.99 (plus \$6,080.00 for Alternate No. I) is the lowest and best bid. Project amount not to exceed \$67,580.00.

Resolution, Approving Amended/Restated CRA

September 20, 2010, Resolution No. 25-2010 was passed authorizing the Village to enter into a Community Reinvestment Area Agreement with OSI Enterprises, located at 3761 Round Bottom Road, Newtown, Ohio, and an adjacent 3.245-acre parcel.

March 14, 2017, Resolution 11-2017 was passed authorizing an Amended and Restated CRA Agreement w/OSI Enterprises in order to extend the dates for which the abatement would be in place in accordance with the delayed construction schedule.

February 21, 2020, a lawsuit was commenced against OSI Enterprises, and others in Hamilton County Court of Common Pleas captioned *Fifth Third Bank, National Association v. OSI Enterprises, et al.,* Case No. A2000852, seeking, among other things, a foreclosure of the property.

April 26, 2020, the Court authorized the court-appointed receiver to sell the Property to Midwest Properties Acquisitions, LLC.

The receiver, on behalf of OSI Enterprises and Midwest Acquisitions seek to enter into an Assignment and Assumption of the Amended and Restated CRA Agreement as part of the sale of Property.
